A breast screen (mammogram) is an X-ray picture of the breast.

Breast screens can find cancers that are too small to see or feel.

Age is the biggest risk for developing breast cancer.

75% of women diagnosed are aged 50 and over.

If you are aged 50 or over, a breast screen **every 2 years** could save your life.

It only takes **10 minutes**, it's with a **woman** and it's **free**.

- All BreastScreen Victoria services are FREE.
- A doctor's referral is not required.
- BreastScreen Victoria is a service for eligible Victorians without any symptoms. If you have any symptoms you should discuss with your GP. Your GP may refer you to a diagnostic mammogram facility to investigate breast symptoms such as a lump, pain, thickening, nipple discharge, or a change in breast size or shape.
- Please advise us if you think you may need extra time or assistance during your visit.
